New Ceramic Museum opening in Savona

The new Museum of Ceramics was inaugurated on the 16th of December 2014 in the heart of the city of Savona.

The museum falls within the restoration of a fifteenth-century building in the historic center of the city, the Palace of Monte di Pietà. The renovation, funded by the Foundation A. Mari and conducted by the designers Poggio Armellino & Associates Architects, Architecture Studio Felluca + Marco Ricchebono, provides a new layout over four floors and also involves the Pinacoteca Civica of Savona, as a starting point of the Museum visit.

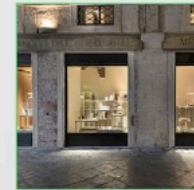
